**Bible Reading**

**1 Corinthians 1:25-30**

**25** For the foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength.

**26** Brothers and sisters, think of what you were when you were called. Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth. **27** But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. **28** God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are, **29** so that no one may boast before him. **30** It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

**Matthew 18:10-14**

**10** “See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven. **[11]** [a]

**12** “What do you think? If a man owns a hundred sheep, and one of them wanders away, will he not leave the ninety-nine on

the hills and go to look for the one that wandered off? **13** And if he finds it, truly I tell you, he is happier about that one sheep than about the ninety-nine that did not wander off. **14** In the same way your Father in heaven is not willing that any of these little ones should perish.

(Mark 11:22-24)
